Reflection

The religion of the Greeks does not yet prosper as I would wish, on account of those who profess it. But the gifts of the gods are great and splendid, better than any prayer or any hope....

Indeed, a little while ago no one would have dared even to pray for such a change, and so complete a one in so short a space of time [~referring to the arrival of Julian himself on the throne~]. Why then do we think that this is sufficient and do not observe how the kindness of Christians to strangers, their care for the burial of their dead, and the sobriety of their lifestyle has done the most to advance their cause?....

For it is disgraceful when no Jew is a beggar and the impious Galileans [~the name by which Julian often referred to the Christians~] support our poor in addition to their own; everyone is able to see that our coreligionists are in want of aid from us.
